If it is necessary to speak with your doctor outside of a normal consultation, please leave a message with reception and your doctor will endeavour to return your call at the end of the session.

Repeat Prescriptions/Referrals/Forms

Appointments are required for all prescriptions, referrals and forms to be completed.

Results

Patients are responsible for making a follow up appointment after having a blood test, x-ray or other tests. If the doctor does require seeing you following a test, one of the receptionists will call and advise you to make a follow up appointment in a time frame specified by the doctor. You will be advised of any urgent result by phone.

Reminders

Reminders can be sent for cervical screenings, repeat tests, health assessments and other preventative health services. Please advise your doctor if you do not wish to receive these.

House Calls

Depending on the circumstance and the doctor availability, a home visit may be organised for existing patients who are unable to attend the practice.

Fees
